Each time you move your laptop to a new location, there are a number of things that need to be adjusted. Whether it’s to make things more secure or personalized, many people spend between five and ten minutes per day adjusting their settings. Which Settings Can Sidekick Control?

Sidekick can control a variety of application and system settings, we call these controls "actions". Actions can be configured in thousands of different combinations and configured to suit all of the places where you use your laptop (home, work, school, the coffee shop, etc.) Here are the actions Sidekick can perform and a few examples to demonstrate how they work:

Action: Open a URL

Example: Launch your favourite news website at work; launch Google Reader when you're at home.

Action: Change the SMTP Servers (Apple Mail)

Example: Having a hard time getting your email out on different networks? Sidekick can make sure you're using the right outgoing mail server wherever you are.

Action: Change the Mail Checking Frequency (Apple Mail)

Example: To stay on top of things at work, get Sidekick to increase how often Mail checks for new messages.

Action: Change your iChat Status

Example: Customize a different status for when you're at work, home, school, wherever!

Action: Open an Application or Run Script

Example: Automatically open GarageBand at home; open your accounting software at work.

Action: Close an Application

Example: Automatically close your chat program when you arrive at work so you can focus on the task at hand.

Action: Play an iTunes Playlist

Example: When you get home from a long day, open up your laptop and relax to your favourite playlist.

Action: Run Command in Terminal

Example: Run shell scripts automatically when you start your work day.

Action: Change the Default Web Browser

Example: If you prefer a specific browser at home, but another at work, Sidekick can switch this automatically for you.

Action: Control iTunes Equalizer

Example: Configure your equalizer to change to "Bass-reducer" at work, and "Electronic" when you're at home, plugged

into your living room speakers.

Action: Change the System Location

Example: Automatically switch between networks and automate changes to proxies, DNS, network devices and more.

Action: Connect to Server

Example: Handy for the work setting, this action will automatically connect your laptop to a specified server.

Action: Change the Default Printer

Example: Use your Lexmark printer at home, but at work, use the Cannon next to that cute intern's desk.

Action: Change Screensaver and Desktop Background Settings

Example: When you're away from home, Sidekick can turn on your screensaver password to keep your work safe.

Action: Lock the Keychain

Example: Get Sidekick to automatically lock your keychain when using your laptop in a public place.

Pause Execution of Actions

Example: A handy tool to use when you need a short delay before connecting to a file server or when doing other network related actions.

Action: Control Spaces

Example: Enable or disable spaces based on your location.

Action: Control Time Machine or Start a Backup

Example: Switch off your Time Machine when you're at the neighbourhood cafe; start a backup as soon as you get home.
